





Invitation/Regulations DSI Dutch Open KARATE ALL-STYLE 2023

1. Generalities

- a. The DSI Dutch Open Karate is held in accordance with International Budo Federation (IBF) karate competition regulations.
- b. The DSI Dutch Open Karate is held to popularize and develop Karate in the Netherlands and the world. And to consolidate international sports relations.
- The Hosting organizer of the DSI Dutch Open in 2023 is Sportcentrum Emsland and Budo Promotion Ommen under auspices of IBF-Karate Nederland.
- d. Leading organisation on the day of the competition is IBF Nederland.

2. Place and dates

- a. <u>Event location:</u> Sportshall 'Trefkoele+', Ruigedoornstraat 108, 7721 BR Dalfsen, The Netherlands.
- b. Date: 11 March 2023

3. Athletes participation

- a. All athletes whatever Federation/Association they are member of. Proof of membership has to be shown at the weigh-in.
- b. Competing athletes must have compulsory health insurance.

4. Application for participation

5. Technical conditions

- The DSI Dutch Open in 2023 is held in accordance with the IBF-rules (<u>www.ibf-nederland.nl</u> or <u>www.ibf-international.org</u>)
- b. Age and Weight categories:

Weight categories Karate All-Style:

11 to 15 years: Boys/Girls: -30, -35, -40, -45, -50, -55, -65, +65 kg 16 years and older: Men -60, -65, -70, -75, -80, -90, +90 kg

Women -55, -65, -75, +75 kg

- c. If one of the weight classes has insufficient participation, classes will be put together. Be sure of a correct registration!
- d. Equipment for the disciplines will be according the official rules (section 5.a.).
- e. The championship organization committee guarantees first aid provision to all athletes.
- f. The athletes who won the prize-winning places shall be rewarded with medals or cups.

6. Financial terms

- a. Heads of sport delegations have to fulfil all financial obligations to the championship organizing committee:
 - 1. Before **18 February 2023** on IBAN NL90ABNA0416753329 (BIC ABNANL2A) of Budo Promotions Ommen (Emslandweg 17, 7731 RP Ommen, the Netherlands).
 - 2. On the day of arrival when it is approved by the organizing committee.







b. The delegations have to pay the participation fee in the amount of (if registered **before** 18 February 2023):

Karate: (weapon-)kata: € 20,00 per athlete

Team-kata: € 50,00 per team (3 persons)

Fights: € 20,00 per athlete

- c. In case of late registration (**after** 18 February 2023) and if the registration is approved by the organization committee the participation fee will be raised with € 5,00 per athlete per discipline.
- d. **Before the 18 February 2023** delegations can change their team quantity. After this date it is only possible to change weight or color of the belt until Wednesday 8 March 2023 and there will be no restitution of participation fee. Changing weight category on the day of the competition will cost € 5,00 per change.
- e. Transportation from railway station (station in the city of Zwolle) to hotel, sports hall and back shall be paid separately in the amount of € 30,00 per person.
- f. The entrance fee for spectators will be € 5,00 per person from 13 years and older. Persons up to 12 years of age pay € 3,00.

7. Accommodation

- a. All delegations can reserve accommodation by themselves.
- b. The organizing committee has special arrangements with **Mercure Hotel** in the city of Zwolle. For booking: reservation@mercurdezwolle.com. Triple room: € 135,00 / double room: € 109,-/ single room: € 89,00 (all **incl.** breakfast, but excl. city tax). Please note that there are limited reservations possible! 8. Accreditation

- a. Accreditation and weigh-in for all delegations will be executed at Sports hall Trefkoele+, Ruigedoornstraat 108, 7721 BR Dalfsen, the Netherlands on Friday 10 March 2023 from 18.00h to 19.00h.
- b. When it is not possible for delegations to go to accreditation on Friday the delegations can go to accreditation on Saturday at the entrance of the Sports Hall before the start of the tournament.

9. Visa request

- a. All delegations that need visa will be supported by the organization committee (please consider that the passport shall be valid not less than 3 months after the last date of your visit to the Netherlands).
